with minimum number of adults needed to run effectively

High school:

- Senior High Youth Group (SHYG) meets twice a month, has occasional outings 4 advisors, plus logistics support (N.B.: we only have 3 advisors this year)
- Annual SHYG service trip to southern California in June
 - 2-3 advisors, plus logistics support
- Youth serve as worship associates
 - Rev. Amy Zucker Morgenstern trains and supervises
- Youth serve as Sunday school teachers
 - Rev. Dan Harper and other teachers train and supervise
- Occasionally youth serve on committees
 - Committee members provide orientation and support
- Summer, 2015, a service trip to Belize approx. 6-8 adults for logistics, and leadership on the trip

Coming of Age (gr. 8-9):

• Coming of Age program where youth write "credo" statements, meets twice a month 4 teachers, plus one mentor per teen (N.B.: we only have 3 teachers this year)

Middle school:

- OWL sexuality education for middle school teens, 27-session program 4 teachers, 1 logistics coordinator
- Weekly Sunday school class which visits other faith communities 4 teachers
- Weekly Sunday school class which does ecojustice projects 4 teachers

Parent programs:

• Four discussion sessions for parents of teens in OWL 2 facilitators

Emerging programs:

• Navigators chapter 41 (our bias-free scouting program) has a few middle schoolers
